# RE-ENACTORS OF THE AMERICAN CIVIL WAR

## VISITING RE-ENACTOR REGISTRATION INFORMATION



The Re-enactors of the American Civil War (R.A.C.W) is happy to have you and your organization participating at our upcoming Civil War reenactment event. This participation requires registration both for the purposes of event planning and for the administration of safety issues as well. This guest registration is applicable only to members of Civil War reenactment organizations, since it presumes a certain amount of prior training and knowledge of reenacting. It considerably reduces the work involved if we receive early indication of attendance and if we are dealing with organized units. Therefore, if these previous requirements are met, the R.A.C.W will allow a discount registration fee for both.

### REGISTRATION FOR EVENTS CAN BE ACCOMPLISHED BY ANY ONE OF THE FOLLOWING MEANS:

1. No limit of numbers (combatants and noncombatants) from one club (any unit), each visitor is asked to complete our Adult Visiting Re-enactor Registration Form (Form 002) or the Minor Visiting Re-enactor Registration Form (Form 003), sign, date, and send to R.A.C.W no later than two weeks prior to event. (ALL members of bonafide Civil War reenacting organizations are exempted from registration fees in lieu of a reciprocity agreement).
2. At the "door" of the event, participants are asked to complete our Adult Visiting Re-enactor Registration Form (Form 002) or the Minor Visiting Re-enactor Registration Form (Form 003), sign, date and pay a fee of \$1.00.

In addition, you must contact the appropriate organizational commanders in advance to gain their permission to attend. Commanders have the authority to turn down guest re-enactors, since they are responsible for the administration of club rules and safety at events. You may additionally be required to contact a unit commander for coordination purposes as well. This particularly applies to artillery and cavalry portrayals, and anyone bringing horses (military or civilian).

Upon receipt of your group's completed application(s), monies, and signed waivers, a packet of Associate Membership Cards (required for participation) will be forwarded to you for distribution among your members. These cards will be required to gain access to the site, so be sure to distribute them to your members and have them sign them. Should anyone lose their card, we will have a notebook, containing all the event waivers on file at the event for verification. This notebook will be held at the front gate if there is a check-in point, otherwise it will be held at the information booth.

Be sure that your members have read the release waivers and a copy of the RACW Safety Rules before signing the waivers. The R.A.C.W. is not responsible for any damages that occur to property or person at events. Please make it clear to your participants, that there is no coverage or reimbursement for injury to property, person, or horse at events.
